### **Transurban's Anzac Day Salute to Diggers**

Transurban, the owner of Hills M2, will waive the M2 toll for war veterans and current Defence Personnel traveling to and from ceremonies on Anzac Day.

Head of Hills M2, John Collier said "Like all Australians, we are proud of our Diggers, and our current servicemen and women. Waiving M2 tolls is a simple way to show our appreciation for their bravery and the sacrifices they have made, and still make, for our nation"

The toll waiver period will commence at 12am on Wednesday April 25 and will end at midnight the same day.

"If you're entitled to have your M2 toll waived, then make sure you drive into a tolling lane which is staffed by a toll booth attendant – these are marked as cash lanes. Show the attendant your service medals and they will exempt you from the toll. Alternatively, if at least one passenger in the vehicle is wearing a military uniform, the attendant will waive the toll for that vehicle," said John Collier.

Motorists who have a Tag and are entitled to the toll waiver must also use the cash lanes to receive their exemption.
