REDUCED SPEED LIMIT IN M2 TUNNEL AS SPRINKLER SYSTEM REPAIRED

The RTA is advising motorists to expect delays on the M2 near the Norfolk tunnel this afternoon.

Reduced speed limits will apply in the M2 tunnel near Beecroft Road as motorway operators carry out repairs to the sprinkler system.

All eastbound and westbound lanes will have a reduced speed limit of 60km/h.

Repairs to the sprinkler system will be carried out in the next few days and motorists are advised to drive safely or take alternative routes.

A fire tanker will remain on standby as a safety precaution while the water system inside the tunnel is turned off to allow repairs to be carried out.

One tunnel will be closed at night to allow the repair work with all lanes open to traffic during peak periods.

As needed during the day one westbound lane may be closed to enable repairs to continue.

Electronic message signs will advise of changed traffic conditions with more information on the RTA and HillsM2 websites.

Motorists are thanked for their patience while this work is carried out.
